

This presentation will include role play interviews of participants with playbacks demonstrating how words can be misrepresented and construed.




Jessica Jackley Flannery is a microfinance pioneer and the cofounder of Kiva, the world's first online micro-lending marketplace for the working poor.

Jessica is the driving force and inspirational spirit of the organization and she speaks to audiences around the world on microfinance, social entrepreneurship and corporate social responsibility.

Named as one of the top ideas in 2006 by the New York Times Magazine and called "revolutionary" by the BBC, Kiva lets internet users lend as little as \$25 to specific small business entrepreneurs around the world, providing affordable capital to help them start or expand their businesses. Kiva has been one of the fastest-growing social benefit Web sites in history, with thousands of people lending millions of dollars to entrepreneurs in over 50 developing countries.

Come join us at the National World War I Museum to hear Marcus Luttrell, a former Petty Officer First Class and United States Navy SEAL, recount one of the amazing survival stories of the past decade. Marcus received the Navy Cross for his actions in 2005 when he faced off against over 100 Taliban fighters during Operation Red Wing.

Marcus was part of an elite Navy Seal team assigned to kill or capture Ahmad Shah a high-ranking Taliban leader responsible for killings in eastern Afghanistan and the Hindu-Kush mountains. He alone survived to tell the story of how they battled enemy fighters for hours. Badly wounded, he managed to walk and crawl seven miles to evade capture until given shelter by tribesmen from Sabri-Minah, a Pashtun village. Six days later he was rescued by US forces. Come hear one of the true heroic stories of the Afghanistan war and meet a true American hero.

After Marcus's story we will have a dinner that will focus on the flavors

of Afghanistan. Be prepared for a lively dinner discussion on the Afghanistan war, as our resources will attempt to discuss what is really happening in the battle with militant Islam. This joint event with WPO is a chance for us to all expand and extend our network.




with Renee Firestone, Holocaust Survivor

At 19 Renee Firestone was imprisoned for 13 months in the infamous concentration camp, Auschwitz/Birkenau during the last years of World War II. Her entire family was murdered except for her father Morris, who died of tuberculosis shortly after liberation, and her brother Frank, who was a partisan.

Following liberation in May of 1945, Renee was reunited with her brother. She settled in Prague, Czechoslovakia, and emigrated to the United States in 1948 with her husband Bernard and her infant daughter Klara. After arriving here, she pursued her love of fashion, becoming a noted designer.

For the past ten years, Renee has been involved with Steven Spielberg's "Survivors of the Shoah Visual History Foundation," an organization which is documenting the testimonies of the remaining survivors of the Holocaust, righteous Gentiles, and military liberators. Renee was one of the five survivors whose experiences were featured in Spielberg's film The Last Days.

Auschwitz was liberated more than 65 years ago and the greatest generation is now in their mid 80's


